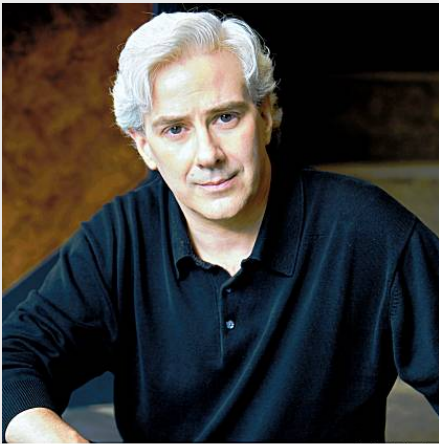

The puppet knights of Sicily to play one show

Direct from Palermo, **Mimmo Cuticchio** and his **Teatro dei Pupi** (Puppet Theater) are bringing the ancient art of Sicilian puppetry to Fort Mason's Cowell Theater for one performance only, April 15 at 7 p.m. The company's traditional 3-foot-tall wooden puppets will perform "The Liberation of Astolfo From Alcina's Island," one of the Renaissance tales of Charlemagne's knights that have long formed the basis of much of the traveling puppet shows of the island.
